Sec. 5 Para. 39 be amended to include PRIMARY CAUSE: the following:-Error in judgment on the part of "Under no circumstances are Aircraft to be taken the pilot Flight Lieutenant R.A. off with frost, ice, or snow on the wings or tail Butts, in that he believed that the planes." **ACTION TAKEN:** snow on the wings of Bigby 748 (A) DISCIPLINARY (B) TECHNICAL (C) OTHER would be blown off during take-off. N.A. SECONDARY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTING FACTORS: Pilot attempted to climb too stemply and with unsufficient RECORDED BY DATE mirenerd for a heavily loaded Digby with snow on the wings, struck trees just after take-off.
