

DUTY ON WHICH ENGAGED: COURT OF INQUIRY, INVESTIGATING OFFICER Solo flying practice. OR COMMANDING OFFICER'S REPORT: Investigating Officer's Report NATURE OF ACCIDENT AND STAGE OF FLIGHT: DATE: 19-5-42 Pupil Pilot on first solo bounced on landing decided to go around again and opened throttle but swing F.O. C.L. Murray No. 33 E.F.T.S. Caron. developed towards airman walking on tarmac. Airman dropped flat on RECOMMENDATIONS: ground was struck by wheel of a/c and a/c turned over. Pupil to be given further instruction in PRIMARY CAUSE: correction of bad landings." Inexperience. ACTION TAKEN: (A) DISCIPLINARY (B) TECHNICAL (C) OTHER Pilots log book endorsed "inexperience". Conclusions of A.I.B. Aircraft ground looped following a bad landing by pilot on his first solo. An airman on duty was run over by the ground-looping, SECONDARY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTING FACTORS: Right wing struck the ground and aircraft. a/c turned over on its back. RECORDED BY CHECKED BY R.C.A.F.
