RECOMMENDATIONS: Recommended that junior pilots be given demonstrations in the handling of A/C by use of engine and rudder PRIMARY CAUSE: and without brakes. CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B. Pilot, comparatively inexperienced on type, failed to taxi his A/C in such a manner as to avoid the Bolingbroke inkethe parking area. (A) DISCIPLINARY (B) TECHNICAL (C) OTHER Pilot's log book endorsed "Inexperience" and Error in Judgment" Accident was remenacted with use of another Battle and it was proved to pilot that swing could have been averted with use of engine and no brake.
