

DUTY ON WHICH ENGAGED: COURT OF INQUIRY, INVESTIGATING OFFICER OR COMMANDING OFFICER'S REPORT: Bunnery exercise. INVESTIGATING OFFICER'S REPOR NATURE OF ACCIDENT AND STAGE OF FLIGHT: DATE: 16-11-42. COMPOSITION: Aircraft collided with tractor on F/L Kelley, T.E. No. 3 B & G School, Macdonald, Man. taxi strip. TCO/PCT RECOMMENDATIONS: Orders defining a maximum taxiing speed should be in Pilot's Orders. PRIMARY CAUSE: Negligence on the part of the pilot in that he apparently was taxiing fast and not watching the taxi strip (A) DISCIPLINARY (B) TECHNICAL (C) OTHER COLLISIONS. CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B. A/C taxiing along taxi strip collided with parked tractor. Pilot who was taxiing too fast, on slippery taxi strip failed to keep sufficient lookout. The tractor was parked temporarily after hauling SECONDARY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTING FACTORS: equipment out of the snow.
