

TECHNICAL OFFICER'S REPORT: PURPOSE OF FLIGHT: ILCG/PCN/C Formation practice. NATURE OF ACCIDENT: A/C crashed into hill in fog. Lost COURT OF INQUIRY OR INVESTIGATING OFFICER'S REPORT: sight of other A/C in formation. 2083 FINDINGS: SUMMARY No. broke off, then went hunting in A/c broke away from formation and was observed by 10/16ths cloud down around a civilian witnesses circling twice in the cloud and mountain ridge and crashed whilst then fly west under power at an altitude of about doing so. 350' dipping wings alternately.
