Battle 1949 FINDINGS: SUMMARY No. 2115 apparently approached from above and CAUSE: Primary: - Battle 1949 contrary to orders, behind and settled down on a/c 5556 attempting to take position on port quarter of striking and severing the tail assembly. Drogue a/c and colliding with Battle 5556 which, A/C 5556 crashed out of control killing again contrary to orders, had already taken up all occupants. Pilot of 1949 abandoned this position. a/c by parachute and a/c 1949 subsequently Secondary: - Sgt. Doucet, pilot of Battle 1949 crahed killing one occupant and seriously failed to keep proper lookout for Battle 5556 injuring the other. he knew to be in vicinity. Recommendation: Increase severity of disciplinary ac tion and revise Filots Order No.54 to eliminate cert-CLASSIFICATION: ain ambiguities. CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B.
