RECOMMENDATIONS: Nil REMARKS OF A.O.C. #I GROUP: Cause of this accident is obscure; disobedience of orders and instructions however is apparent in respect of (a) Unguthorized carrying of passengers on a practice bombing flight. (b) Unauthorized carrying of Naval rating. (c) Failur. to properly enter names of passengers in F.A.B. (d) Failure to file an adequate flight plan particularly in respect to ETA. Gross carelessness and lack of CLASSIFICATION: judgment were exhibited in respect of (a) Carrying passengers and dymamite. (b) Loose stowage of bags of dynamite (possibly in a deteriorated state) in a/c. Flight was not only poorly organized but was inadequately controlled by F.C. and Sadn in that the a/c was long over the prior to anyone appearing to know anything about it. CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B.
