CAUSE: (a)Mid-air collision Pilots error on part of P/O Wood in #5 in colliding with Sgt Endersby's a/c #3. RECOMMENDATIONS: Severe disciplinary action for the breaking of Pilot's Orders No. 64 para.2". REMARKS OF O.C. Concur in findings. CLASSIFICATION: CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B. Agree with findings. NOTE: While agreeing with findings, it should be pointed out that the evidence is not clear that P/r Good and Sat Endersby were told what positions they were to fly in the formation. There is evidence SECONDARY OR CONTRIBUTORY FACTORS: that the pilots were briefed but no proper or the ACTION TAKEN: other evidence that they were briefed at the same time and together or just what NIT. that briefing was.
