

PURPOSE OF FLIGHT: TECHNICAL OFFICER'S REPORT: Instructors Practice. NATURE OF ACCIDENT: A/C crashed into trees whilst COURT OF INQUIRY OR INVESTIGATING OFFICER'S REPORT: flying below 1000 outside SUMMARY No. 2373 FINDINGS: low flying area. CAUSE: A/C was flown at a dangerously low altitude one that did not allow sufficiently for recovery from unusual position. Pilot was on duty at time and was practicing unauthorized low flying 50 miles out- 7 side the authorized local flying area. RECOMMENDATIONS: All local authorities within reasonable flying range of all service aerodromes be repeat edly and periodically impressed with the necessity of) reporting all incidents of low flying in their abea with a view to stopping occurences of this kind. CLASSIFICATION: obotios. CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B. This accident was a result of deliberate unauthorized low flying aerobatics at low altitude.
