

PURPOSE OF FLIGHT: TECHNICAL OFFICER'S REPORTS Routine training flight. NATURE OF ACCIDENT: Pupil pilot was overshooting while COURT OF INQUIRY OR INVESTIGATING OFFICER'S REPORT: carrying out a powered approach. He FINDINGS: SUMMARY No. was told to take overshot action. He opened up to 1/2 throttle but port engine did not respond. Carb heat was being used air temperature 10°c, carb temp 10°c. Instructor took over and closed both) throttles to check the swing. He then peopened throttles, the port engine did not respond. Instructor closed both throttles decided to land straight ahead but omitted to maintain sufficient airspeed, a/c landed CLASSIFICATION: heavily on port u/c which collapsed. Overshooting runway.
