LAC Hubert was approaching A/C and pilot seeing the two pupils instantly killed and LAC Hodge was walking close to A/C failed to keep them in sight. injured but not seriously. RECOMMENDATIONS 1. Right angle crossing of taxi strip from hangar side to parking side. 2. Pupil occupy turret while taxiing and act as lookout for pilot. 3. Pilots bring A/C to a stop when anyone comes within 201 of any part of a moving A/C.4. All personnel using tarmac, except tarmac crew, keep outside of area CLASSIFICATION: designated in No. 3. 5. Warning to pilots that 57. Miscellaneous. strong disciplinary action will follow negligence in taxiing. CONCLUSIONS OF A.I.B. SECONDARY OR CONTRIBUTORY FACTORS: Agree with findings. 24.
