NATURE OF ACCIDENT AND STAGE OF FLIGHT:

Landed in deep snow with wheels, overturning aircraft, breaking prop and damaging tail fin and rudder. Pupil attempted forced landing approach and when recovery was attempted the motor spluttered and coughed and he stalled in.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Give this airman particular warning that any repetition of this nature will cause his training to be discontinued. Circulate final warning that no aircraft are to approach closer than 200 ft. and motors must be given occasional bursts to keep them warm.

PRIMARY CAUSE:

Not keeping motor warm and opening the throttle so quickly that it choked at the last moment. Not recovering at 200 ft.
