RECOMMENDATIONS:

Pupils have been warned to pay more attention to navigation and to fix position after every aerobatic manoeuvre.

PRIMARY CAUSE:

Because of snow $1\frac{1}{2}$ feet deep, aircraft was landed with tail in low position and a/c dropped from approximately 8 ft. resulting in damage to the oleo leg.
