FLYING TRAINING.

NATURE OF ACCIDENT AND STAGE OF FLIGHT:

PILOT LANDED A/C WITH DRIFT ON, PORT WING  
DROPPED, STRUCK GROUND, CAUSING DAMAGE  
TO WING TIP AND AILERON.

PRIMARY CAUSE:

PILOT LANDED A/C ON RUNWAY IN A STRONG CROSS  
WIND.

SECONDARY CAUSE OR CONTRIBUTING FACTORS:

A GROUND LOOP RESULTING WHEN A/C LANDED IN  
CROSS WIND . WHEN THE A/C STRUCK THE GROUND  
AND RAN OFF THE RUNWAY THE RIGHT WING AND STATIC  
CONTROLS WERE DAMAGED.
