Extract from Casualty Report dated 16th May, 1944.

Sgt. R. ANDERSON

Serv. No. R.191468 PoW No.4176 states:

"On the night of 20th/21st, April, 1944 our aircraft was directly hit by flak near DIEPPE. The aircraft caught fire and the order to bale out was given. I was second to leave the aircraft. I was taken to YUETOT with Sgt. BOURCIER. I identified the bodies of F/Sgt. WHEELHOUSE and W/O WILSON and they were buried near Yuetot."
