Please refer to our Air Mail List No.159. The father of F/Sgt. R.A. ANDERSON, POW No.4176, Stalag Luft III, has received a letter from F/Sgt. Anderson with the information that Anderson and Gnr. Paul Beaubier were the only members of the crew taken prisoner. We have a record of course of F/Sgt. Anderson as a prisoner of war but, we have no record of Beaubier.

Anderson further stated that W.O.2: Wilson was buried near Dieppe. Mrs. Wilson, mother of this airman, is anxious to have some further particulars, if available. She has not received any advice from the Casualty Officer of the R.C.A.F. of the details given in F/Sgt. Anderson's letter.

We shall be grateful if you would check with the Air Ministry and let us have any available information.
